Prayers etc.

**St Aidan:** born in Ireland. St Aidan died in Bamburgh in 651. A monk of Iona, he was sent to Northumbria when King Oswald asked for help in converting his kingdom and established his monastery on the island of Lindisfarne. Assisted by king Oswald and later king Oswin, Aidan preached the Gospel, founded churches and monasteries and liberated slaves throughout the kingdom. Since the testimony of Bede. He has been venerated for his simplicity and poverty. for his love of prayer and the scriptures and for his care of the sick and the poor  
With him are also remembered all those holy abbots and bishops, teachers and missionaries who made Lindisfarne a cradle of English Christianity.
